Pursuant to the order made by Richard Morneau, Prothonotary, on April 3, 1997, dismissing the Plaintiff's action with costs for want of prosecution an appointment was issued for costs to be taxed on October 14, 1997. On that date, Claudie Senay submitted her bill in the amount of \$1,141.45. The Plaintiff was not present or represented at hearing.

The Defendant is claiming under Tariff B, Column III, items 2 (5 units), 5 (3 units), and 26 (3 units). Applying the criteria set down in Rule 346(1.1), the requested units, with the exception of the claim made under item 26, are awarded as such. I feel that 2 units for taxation of costs is fair given that the proceeding was uncontested and the bill submitted was relatively simple. The disbursements of \$41.45 for service are also accepted.

The costs of the Defendant are taxed in the amount of \$1,041.45 and a certificate is issued accordingly.
